**Director's Report**

### **Materials and Services**

- The Northstar Digital Literacy project has wrapped up for 2014, however the Moorhead Library will continue this grant project in 2015. In 2015 the library plans to conduct more outreach with Adult Basic Education.

### **Library Activity**

- One Book, One Community events included a book discussion and documentary screening.
- The Moorhead Library hosted a book discussion on Roxana Saberi's "Between Two Worlds" in conjunction with the Gamechanger series the North Dakota Humanities Council had in October.
- The Moorhead Library began a Youth Study Room in September. Youth Study Room is on Monday afternoons.
- The Moorhead Library hosted the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Not So Silent Auction on October 4<sup>th</sup>. This fundraiser resulted in \$1,650.00 for the LARL budget.
- The Moorhead Library hosted a Legislative Forum in conjunction with the League of Women Voters of the Red River Valley on October 11<sup>th</sup>.
