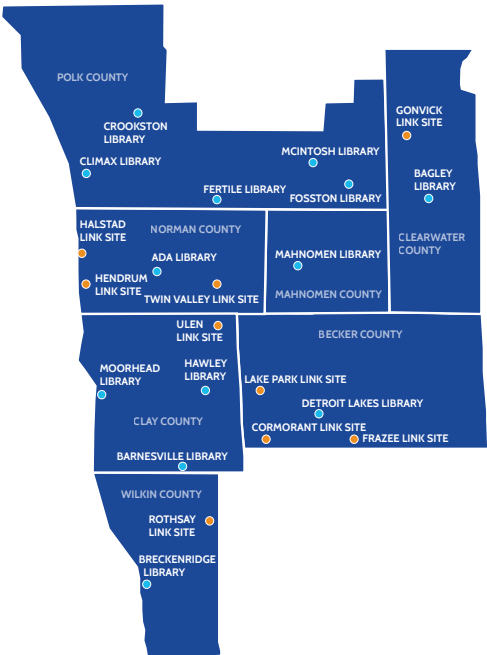
# From the Director
