LARL Board meeting report on May18, 2023

House and Senate both signed off on MLA's request for the 2023 Legislative session. The changes include a Regional Library Basic System Support formula change, and increase of \$4M in funding, with the funding indexed in the future. Libraries will also see an increase in Legacy funding from the current \$2.5M to \$2.75M for the next biennium. The governor still needs to sign off on the final funding bill. The amount of increases that LARL will see are not know at this point, but should be known by August.

1. Financial Report

- With 33.33% of 2023 complete, LARL spent 33.11% of budgeted expenses as of April 30, 2023.
- LARL Endowment Fund was approved to reinvest the full annual distributions from the F-M Area Foundation for Moorhead Library (\$175)
- 2024 Preliminary Budget Review Draft #2 was approved.

2. Director's Report

- ♦ LARL News
 - On Monday, May 8, the Moorhead City Council unanimously approved JLG Architecture
 of Fargo and Miller Hull of Seattle to design the Moorhead Public Library/LARL
 Headquarters/Community Center. The goal is to have design concepts ready this fall.
- ♦ Minnesota Poets Out Loud: Spoken Word Poetry from the Land of 10,000 Voices
 - Seven poets traveled to 12 LARL locations during the week of April 25. The poets
 provided an energetic spoken word poetry presentation featuring diverse voices from
 across Minnesota. Events were held in school, community centers, and libraries –
 Moorhead Library on April 29 –, and received rave reviews.
