#### LARL Board meeting report on March 27, 2025

## 1. 2024 Audit Report by Brady, Martz & Associates, P.C. Thief River Fall, Minnesota

- In connection with our audit, <u>nothing came to our attention</u> that caused us to believe that the library failed to comply with the provisions of the contracting and bidding, deposits and investment, conflict of interest, claims and disbursements, and miscellaneous provisions of the Minnesota Legal Compliance Audit Guide for Other Political Subdivisions, promulgated by the State Auditor pursuant to Minn. Stat. §6.65, insofar as they relate to accounting matters.
- 2024 total revenues were \$4,313,410 and <u>operating grants and contributions</u> (signatory funding, state grants, investment earnings, miscellaneous, special projects) accounted for 97 percent of total revenue for the year.
- The total cost of all programs and services was \$4,048,504. LARL's expenses are predominantly related to staffing headquarters, branch libraries, and LINK sites.
- Total revenues were greater than expenses, increasing net position by \$264,906 from last year.
- Expenditures exceeded appropriations by \$198,279 in the general fund. The over-expenditures were funded by greater than anticipated revenues.

#### 2. Financial Report

- With 16.67% of 2025 complete, LARL spent 16.44% of budgeted expenses as of February 28, 2025.
- Approved to authorize the Director of Finance to submit the 2024 Annual Report to State Library Services.
- Approved the Final Report for State Regional Public Library System Arts and Cultural Heritage Program for FY2023 funding year.

#### **LARL News**

#### hoopla:

• LARL discontinued the LARL hoopla subscription, effective January 31. The cost-per-transaction model is unsustainable for the LARL collection budget. LARL will use the hoopla funds to enhance the LARL subscription to the Libby (Overdrive) eBook, audiobook, and magazine app.

#### **Book Blizzard:**

• During the months of January & February, LARL challenged customers to read various genres to win a Book Blizzard prize. There were 444 entries in 2025.

## **2025 Minnesota Legislative Priorities**

- Legacy (HF1790): \$3M per year appropriation in Arts & Cultural Heritage Funding for public library systems.
- Capital Investment: \$10M appropriation for Library Construction Grant funding and raise grant to \$2M
- Minitex (HF2065) Ed Finance Committee: \$2M per year increase for eLibrary Minnesota resources.
- Minitex: \$1.5M per year increase for operating funding.

### **Programs and Services**

Family Resource Center Office Hours

The Moorhead Public Library has entered into a partnership with the Clay County Family Resource Center to provide the space needed to bring much needed services to community members. The Family Resource Center will begin offering weekly office hours at the library starting sometime in April. Exact hours are yet to be determined.

#### **AARP Tax Assistance**

The Moorhead Public Library has partnered with AARP again this year to provide space for the organization to offer tax assistance to the public. We have welcomed over 600 people through our doors so far this winter through this partnership.

#### Library Activity

I am happy to report that visits to the library are up so far in 2025. January and February statistics show a 22% increase in meeting room usage and a 9% increase in gate count compared to 2024.

### **Upcoming Events**

LARL's spring Legacy event series is now underway and we are lucky to host many of these events at the Moorhead Public Library. These include children's program Imagination Theater with Michael Paul Gallo, an author visit with Leif Enger, a canoeing presentation with author and adventurer Rollie Johnson, and more. In addition to our Legacy series, Moorhead Library staff are busy planning and hosting several other events.
